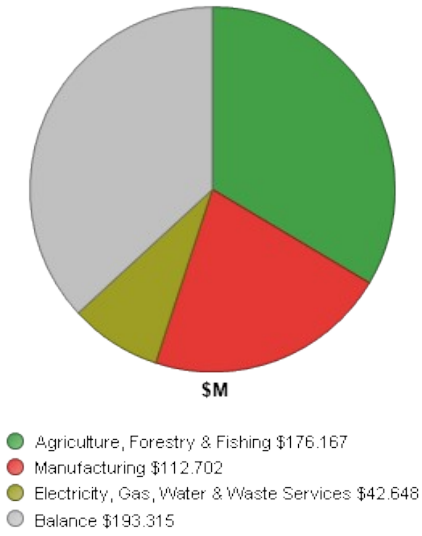

Output - Goyder (DC) (2022 Release 2)



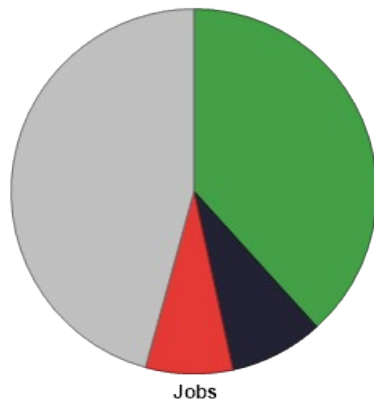

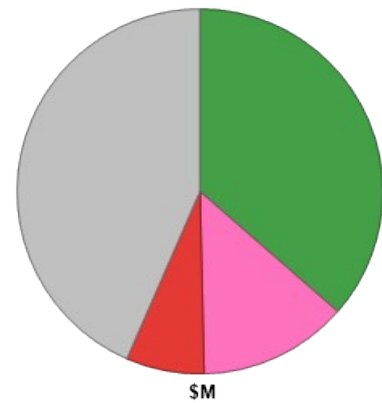
