

How to resize images for ATDW - Mac

1. Open the image in Preview
2. Click on the icon with the pencil in a circle 
3. Firstly, if the image is portrait (long) then you will need to crop it to a landscape (wide). Use the select tool to outline the landscape section of the image, then click the crop tool.
4. Select the Adjust Size icon 
5. This will bring up this menu.

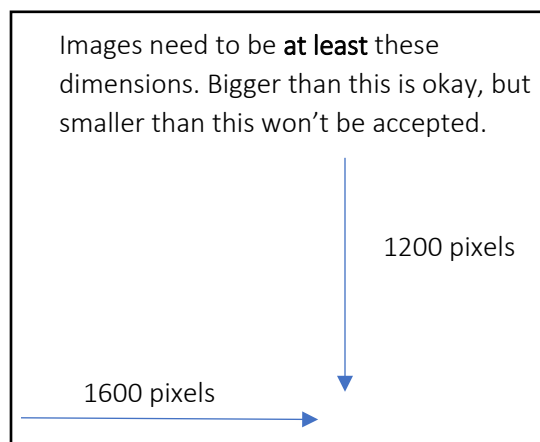

6. Change the smaller number to meet the requirements of ATDW (above). So in this scenario, the height would be changed to 1200. This automatically changes the other number to be larger than the minimum, therefore large enough for ATDW.
7. Remember to SAVE AS your image file so that the original is not overwritten.
