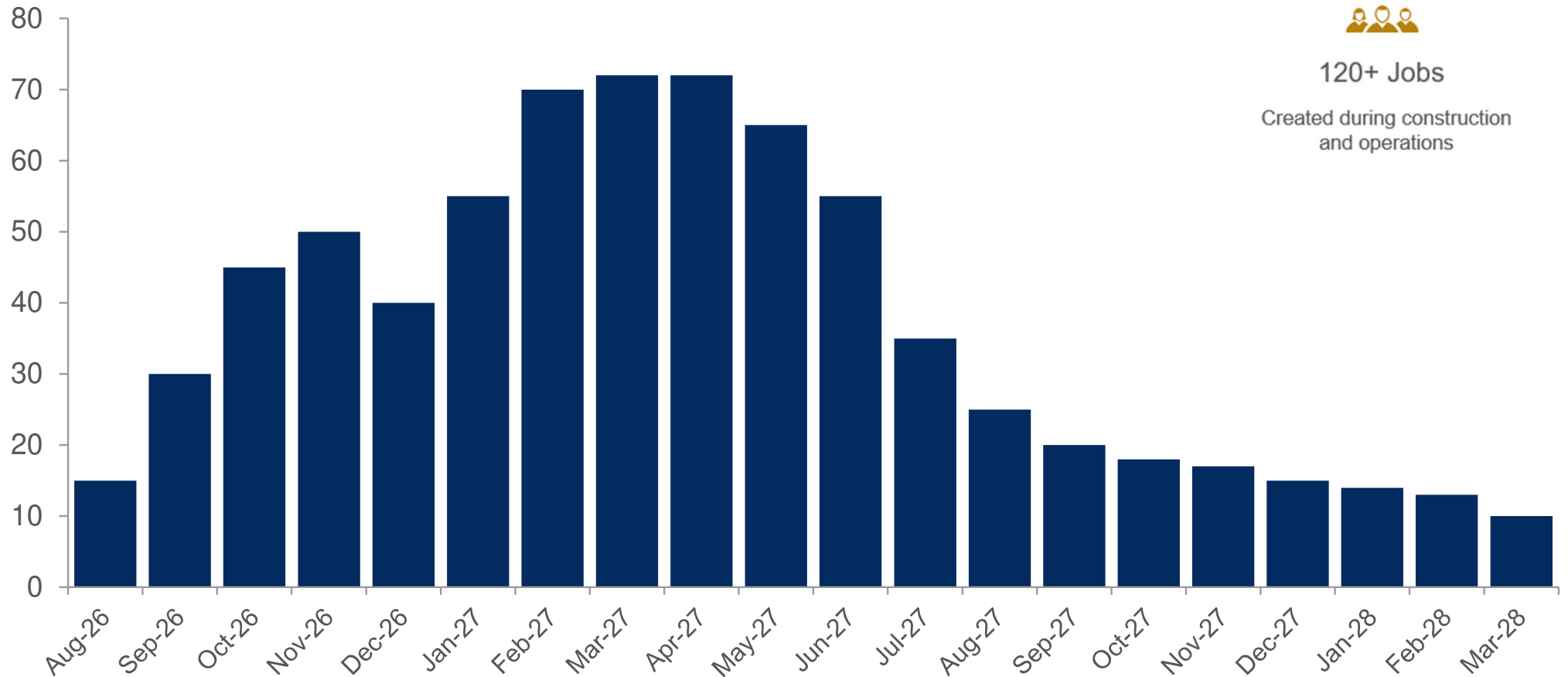


Construction Process – Storage

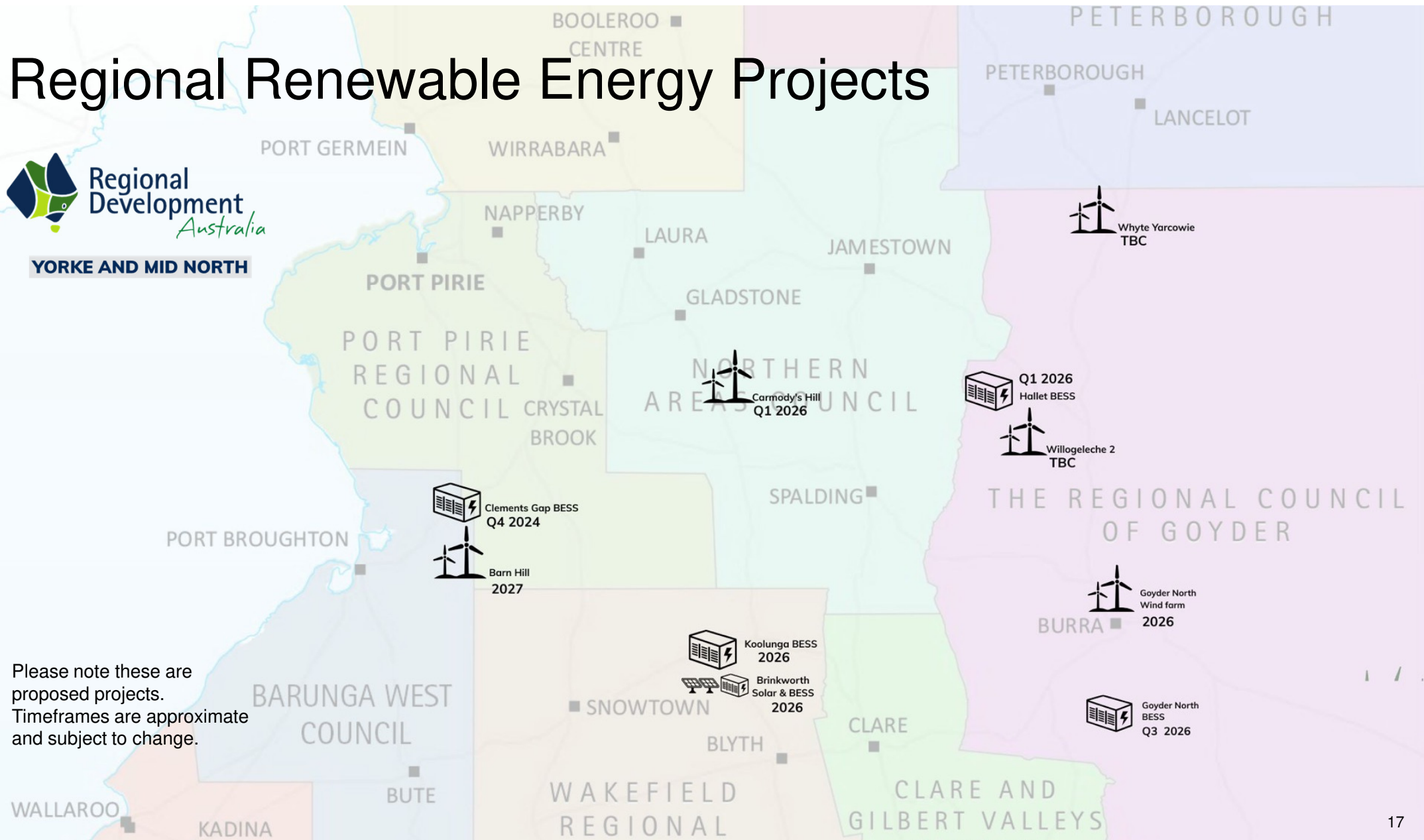
